

L. Paul releases new single “Green” on 1st February 2019

Singer/Songwriter L. Paul’s second single “Green” is to be released on 1st February 2019 through DistroKid, under his label Collectic. Clearly emerging as a talent to watch, Paul has written and produced all the music he’s put out so far, including the 2017 EP “Outis”.

The new single is already being supported by Spanish, Italian, and Mexican radio stations, countries where he has lived before moving to London in 2018, and where he has a growing following. His music is also being featured on a variety of Spotify playlists.

“Green” is yet another one of the colours Paul has explored through his songs. After “Red&Blue” and “Purple Lights” (2018), the songwriter delves, on his latest single, into the ever-changing human nature and the consequences it has on the broken remains of a relationship.
